## **white wines**

**2008 breathmaker 'white labe' dry white                      murray valley, vic                      30**

the breathtaking white label dry white is sourced from a family run winery that was established in 1988. it is a classic unwooded style of wine that is loaded with fresh white peach and a zippy palate feel.

**2008 the 'flaming dog' riesling    margaret river, wa                      33**

from one of the un heralded riesling producing area's in australia, these are powerful dry styles of riesling that have a soft floral nose but lead into a zesty citrus palate. a brilliant food wine which will enhance any seafood meal.

**2008 chrismont lazona arneis    king valley, vic                      40**

the variety originates from barolo in italy and has taken a foot hold within the king valley. its rich palate is loaded with nashie pear characters. an easy drinking style of wine that is great to sip on or pair up with a hearty meal. we hope you enjoy this wine as much as we do.

**2008 'squires peak' sauvignon blanc    marlborough, nz                      35**

produced by the famous vavasour winery in marlborough this wine has received 5 star ratings in publications like winestate and cuisine. the lifted nose is filled with tropical characters which lead into a palate driven by intense passionfruit. lovely depth and hints of grass on the finish.

**2008 breathmaker 'white label' sauvignon blanc                      adelaide hills, sa                      35**

the adelaide hills is considered to be australia's premier sauvignon blanc region. the wonderfully delicate nose is filled with orange blossom and passionfruit. the intense palate is packed with excellent tropical fruit yet retains a dry citrus finish.

**2006 'the journey' pinot gris    hawkes bay, nz                      38**

a classic french style which is wonderfully crafted wine in a market that so often disappoints. it has a rich nose and palate yet still retains a light finish. highly recommended.

**2006 breathmaker 'white label' chardonnay                      margaret river, wa                      40**

crafted by an exceptional young wine maker comes this classic chardonnay from margaret river. elegant stone fruit rolls from the glass and leads into a palate dominated by apple, pear and guava. the oak influence doesn't dominate yet still adds complexity to the mouth feel.

**2007 'kooyong clonale' chardonnay    mornington, vic                      55**

a lovely example of mornington chardonnay, where the rich oak draws you into a complex world of stone fruit and creamy overtones.

## red wines

- 2004 breathmaker 'black label' shiraz** **bendigo, vic** **30**  
the breathtaking black label shiraz is in its second vintage in our restaurant. by strong demand we sourced more for this ski season.
- 2006 'evolution' pinot noir** **mornington, vic** **45**  
trying to find a good pinot noir at a reasonable price can be a challenge. look no further. rhubarb drifts from the glass and lures you into a vibrant palate that has brilliant structure and intensity. a little more powerful than many of mornington's pinot noir it will tantalise any pinot lover.
- 2006 'the climbing vine' merlot** **yarra valley, vic** **34**  
after a tragic year for the yarra valley through the bushfires we found a small producer in steele's creek with a fantastic merlot. soft plums roll over the tongue this wine is backed with fine grained tannins and balanced with a spicy oak influence.
- 2007 'cape baron' gsm** **mclaren vale, sa** **45**  
this classic rhone inspired blend is sourced from two vineyards from willunga and blewitt springs in mclaren vale. an outstanding drinking wine that is smooth yet packed with an enormous amount of flavour and personality. a gold medal wine at the adelaide wine show it is a must try wine this winter.
- 2008 breathmaker 'black label' cabernet sauvignon coonawarra, sa** **35**  
made by the guru peter bissell (qantas wine maker of the year 2005) comes this classic coonawarra cabernet sauvignon. powerful blackberry fruit combines with the firm tannin backbone and hints of mint.
- 2003 brown brothers 'patricia' cabernet sauvignon king valley, vic** **55**  
its nice to show customers a serious wine with a little bottle age. rich colour with a combination of mixed berries, nutmeg and subtle french oak influences. a real winner and has just been awarded a gold medal in the sydney wine show.
- 2005 breathmaker 'old bugger' shiraz** **heathcote, vic** **40**  
there is a reason why many consider heathcote to be the ideal region for shiraz. a super-rich palate filled with ripe berry and plum characters combine with a chocolate brownie edge. an intense, yet drinkable wine.
- 2005 'skillogallee' shiraz** **clare valley, sa** **60**  
one of our favourite producers in the clare valley. the velvet hammer has spent 24 months in a combination of french and american hogshead and is wonderfully balanced.
